COSMETOLOGY 2-year program

GateWay Community College's Cosmetology Program prepares students to compete in the rapidly growing, and diverse Beauty and Wellness industry

As a Cosmetology professional in training, you will learn the fundamental skills of various hair services such as hair composition, hair analysis, hair care essentials, cutting, chemical texture, coloring, fashion trends, hair enhancements, product chemistry, consultation, and retailing

Skin care services will include skin composition, analysis, facial services, facial massage, temporary hair removal, lash and brow tinting, temporary artificial eyelash application, makeup application, product chemistry, and consultation

Nail care services include nail composition, analysis, manicuring, pedicuring, hand/foot massage, gel and acrylic nail enhancement application and maintenance, and skin product chemistry



COSMETOLOGY 2-year program

Students will be taught soft skills, marketing techniques, resume creation, and interviewing skills to promote strong industry-ready professionals.

General science basics are taught in anatomy, physiology, microbiology, integumentary system, and ergonomics.

Graduates of this program will earn a certificate of completion. GateWay Community College does not guarantee licensure.

Licensure is granted by the Arizona Barbering and Cosmetology Board upon successful application, submission, and passing of a state examination.



COLLEGE REGISTRATION

TUITION

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is mandatory.100% of course hours must be met by course end date

Makeup time is scheduled on designated Fridays per course. Two class days available, 10 hours

Students who fall below attendance benchmark may be dropped each course

Students must be on track to earn all required 1500 program hours



ATTENDANCE

Students will clock in and out using a personal electronic device through our SATS attendance system within the Student Center

Students will be trained on how to use the attendance system and policies

Students are expected to track their hours

Students will communicate attendance questions and concerns with their Instructor via Canvas email

Students will sign an attendance roster daily. Student hours are reported to AZBCB monthly

GRADING

Students will be evaluated on theoretical knowledge by written and practical examinations, workbook assignments, case studies, and oral recall

All evaluations are based on Arizona Barbering and Cosmetology Board standards, subject to additional competencies at the <u>Instructor's discretion</u>

Students will be evaluated daily on professional demeanor, industry-ready hygienic appearance, communication skills, employability, punctuality, problem-solving skills, and proper use of industry jargon



GRADING

Students will be evaluated daily on practical skill ability by skill-based rubrics, services on manikins and humans, timing to complete services, and must display continued improvement of techniques learned

Students must meet all practical skill competencies and obtain a passing score on each course rubric

Failure to meet practical and/or theoretical knowledge competency standards may result in removal from the program

*An **80% grade or better is required to pass each course** to continue in the Cosmetology program. Students will be dropped if an 80% is not achieved by the course end date
