Hosted by West-MEC's very own Speranta Klees (Postsecondary Partnership Manager), Dr. Aaron Parsons (Southwest Campus Administrator), and Patrick Clawson (Professional Development Specialist), they will expound upon how and why CTE can help young men academically.

According to the National Center for Education Statistics, for every 100 women enrolled in U.S. colleges, there are only 77 men enrolled. There are many reasons why colleges have been seeing this downward trend the last few decades, which will be discussed in detail in the webinar. CTE is a solution to help remedy the alarming decline in academic performance and propel young men into successful postsecondary attainment.
