Project SEARCH is an international program model empowering young adults with disabilities to make a successful transition from school to adult life. Participants will be taught relevant, marketable skills while immersed in the working world.

Distribution Logistics | 1080 hours

Project Search - Distribution Logistics at Core-Mark ADC provides young people with disabilities comprehensive training in distribution logistics coupled with quality unpaid internships for hands-on training and career exploration.

West-MEC staff deliver Distribution Logistics and general employability curricula during the morning classroom; instruction is reinforced as interns acquire employability and competitive work skills through rotation assignments. The program takes place entirely within Core-Mark's distribution facility. Interns receive support, as needed, in their rotations. The goal for each intern upon completion of the program is competitive employment in the community.
